MPM CENTER MINISTRY:

The hairdressing school across the street from the Center is doing well. A group of around 18 of them, both young men and women, come into the Center on a regular basis. This year, we have not had the spiritual contact we would like, but we pray that God will open their hearts to the Gospel. We have asked for prayer for *Kelly* several times this past year. Because of her disruptiveness and bad attitude, she has been transferred to another branch of the school across town. I have had some contact with her and it looks like she has taken a turn more towards immorality and away from her research for the truth about the Lord. Please continue to uplift her in prayer.

Our ministry to the (mainly) guys in the neighborhood around the Center is doing well, but remains few in number. Right now, we have *Samy* and *David*, who come on a regular basis.

Also, a group of young men come in, who are off the street, have no job, and live wherever they can. They seem well behaved and are easy to get along with, but no interest, as yet, in spiritual things. Recently, I was able to talk to *David* (another) and *Julie* about the Lord. *Samy* is still the only one who comes to our Friday afternoon Bible study.

In order to interest more in studying the Bible, we recently added a Wednesday evening time to study. This would allow those who work during the day to come and then, we pray that some military might be drawn to our little group. Thus far, *Samy* and *Eric* have come with another couple interested in coming from time to time. We have invited a number of people to the study and pray that the Lord will bring some to a saving knowledge of Christ and that any Christian, who might come, to growth in Him.

Ministry in and through Eglise Biblique Baptiste (our church in Toulon West):

Our church continues to go forward. Attendance has been good, about the same as reported in our last communication. *Phil*, the U.S. Navy Exchange Pilot, is out to sea until sometime next year. The ship he is on has been experiencing some mechanical problems, but things should be back in order soon. While he is away, *Julie Gribbin* has come over from the States to help *Sarah* with the kids and everyday affairs. Julie is looking for work, either in the States or here, in France. She just finished her college degree at Liberty University. I know *John and Joy* are happy that she can be closer to home for a while.

I would like you to pray for the *Mahobah* family (**pictured here**). They are faithful members of our little group of believers. *Jef* is finishing up some job training and is now looking for full-time work. *Sara* has been working while *Jef* finished his schooling, but now, will take time off for maternity leave. They are expecting their third child early next year. *Jef* has been a great help in the church, leading singing, and preaching from time to time. Pray that the Lord would continue to use them. Also, that he might be able to find work soon.



Cyndi continues to have a multi-outreach ministry. She is leading the ladies group in Toulon West through a study of 1st and 2nd Thessalonians this year. She is also helping teach the Epistles of John in the Toulon East group. She teaches an English conversation class to a group of men and women on Tuesdays, and she continues with *Sheila*. We recently had the privilege of meeting some of *Sheila's* family. A few are saved but most are not. Please continue to pray for these opportunities of ministry.



MPM recently had a special outreach in the Center for the military families that we know (**pictured here**). We had supper together and then *John Gribbin* did a PowerPoint presentation on the Resurrection of Christ. Some of the men who came are now on deployment.
